

ANC Meeting Minutes
May 11, 2006

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson McVey at 7:29 PM. Commissioners Lucy Eldridge and Anne Sullivan were also in attendance.

Commissioner McVey immediately made a motion to amend the special election rules for the ANC 3E03 race so that the voting could begin at 7:30 PM instead of 7:45 PM. Commissioner Eldridge seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Voting for the ANC 3E03 Commissioner commenced immediately following the passing of the aforementioned motion.

There were no announcements or topics raised during the announcement portion and the open forum portion at the beginning of the meeting.

Lt. Aiello gave information regarding the beginning of monthly meetings that he plans to host. There will be an announcement in Kathy Smith's Communit-E newsletter with details. Lt. Aiello would like for citizens to bring their concerns to the monthly meeting, and the agenda will be set by interested citizens. Lt. Aiello went on to give a crime statistics analysis for April 2nd to May 2nd. Basically, crime has declined from 43 crimes in the same time period last year to 28 crimes this year. Lt. Aiello described two robberies that occurred this week that were both closed. He announced that Andrew Solberg is the new Acting Commander for PSD 2, and that he might come to a future ANC meeting.

Rick Bellman from Paul's Liquors was present to ask for the ANC to not oppose the renewal of Paul's Liquors' liquor license. After a brief discussion in which there were no negative comments regarding Paul's Liquors, Chairperson McVey moved that the ANC not oppose the liquor license. Commissioner Eldridge seconded and the motion pass unanimously.

Chairperson McVey again allowed for an open forum portion of the meeting. Mrs. Rosemary Bowen remarked that she would like to see the zoning laws enforced for the possible development project behind Rodman's store. A resident from the 4400 block of Warren Street wondered why some of the grass around the reservoir near his home doesn't get mowed on a regular basis. He also was concerned about rising property taxes, and Chairperson McVey said she would get the name and phone of Councilmember Phil Mendelson's assistant that the resident could contact regarding this issue.

ANC Business

Chairperson McVey moved to approve the April meeting minutes, Commissioner Eldridge seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

The Treasurer's report was circulated by Commissioner Anne Sullivan, a motion for approval was made by Chairperson McVey, Commissioner Eldridge seconded and the motion was approved unanimously.

A discussion of the past approval for funds for a laptop computer to be used by the ANC consultant/administrative assistant ensued. Logistics for buying the laptop were discussed.

The quarterly treasurer's report was submitted by Commissioner Anne Sullivan for approval; a motion was made by Chairperson McVey to approve, it was seconded by Commissioner Eldridge, and the motion passed unanimously.

SPECIAL ANC 3E03 ELECTION RESULT:

The votes were tallied and the winner was announced: Carolyn Sherman won the election. She had 111 votes, her opponent had 44, and there was one write-in vote. The ANC Chairperson made a motion to approve Carolyn Sherman as the ANC 3E03 Commissioner, Commissioner Sullivan seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Chairperson McVey made a motion to end the meeting at 8:45 PM; the motion was seconded and approved.
