

These notes memorialize the conversations that ANC special committee members have had with a variety of DC government officials. In each case, we posed hypothetical questions based on the materials Roadside has provided to our committee. Our goal has not been to represent Roadside's proposal to these officials (all of whom seem to have had some prior contact with Roadside on the matter prior to our conversations) but to gain an understanding of how various branches of DC government analyze public-private partnerships.

Roadside has not yet produced a formal proposal for the Tenley Library-Janney Elementary site so, obviously, none of these comments should be interpreted as anyone's official opinion on the merits of an as-yet-undefined deal.

We greatly appreciate the openness of these officials in discussing this issue with us. Our community would not be able to make an informed decision about this kind of project if we were forced to rely solely on developers' representations of how various branches of DC government make decisions.
