

**Resolution of nonsupport for the application of Tenley Historical Society's
for historic designation of Burrows House**

WHEREAS the Tenley Historical Society ("THS") has applied to the Historic Preservation Review Board to have the Burrows House, located at 4520 River Road, Northwest, designated as a historical landmark;

WHEREAS in its application, THS noted that the house is one of the oldest in American University Park, having been built in the late 1800s and is built in the Queen Anne style;

WHEREAS some members of the community as well as the current property owner, holding the property as an estate executor with a fiduciary duty, objected to the designation based on the poor condition of the property and the need for extensive and expensive renovations to the property;

THEREFORE, ANC 3-E agreed not to support the application of Tenley Historical Society for historic designation of the Burrows house, located at 4520 River Road, Northwest.

ANC 3-E approved this resolution 4-1 (Commissioner DiBiase dissenting) on June 14, 2001. Commissioners present were Jill Diskan, Chris McNamara, Leslie Quynn, Frank Gordan and Tad DiBiase.
