This letter is to request that DDOT undertake a traffic study of the Tenleytown area as soon as possible and we strongly suggest that ANC 3E have input regarding the boundaries of the study.

It is our understanding that you, along with Carolyn Pollack and Ling Li met with Armond Spikell of Madison Retail to discuss the traffic situation around the development project located at Wisconsin Avenue and Albemarle Street, NW. Mr. Spikell has forwarded the list of roadway modifications that are being proposed to ease the traffic burden to the neighborhood.

We believe it to be imperative that this Tenleytown traffic study be started and completed in the near future, prior to any traffic adjustments being implemented, as the results of such study could be extremely helpful in the our considerations of proposed developments in our area.
