**Resolution Concerning the Possibility of Additional Playing Fields**  
**at Fort Reno Park**

**WHEREAS:** the National Park Service (NPS) and the D.C. Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) entered into a General Agreement, dated December 3, 2003, to maintain the existing ball field at Fort Reno Park and to develop and maintain a new ball field there as well.

**WHEREAS:** ANC 3E supports the project contemplated by the General Agreement, and urges DPR to continue planning for the creation of new fields as quickly as possible.

**WHEREAS:** ANC 3E would like to see a plan that would include an additional youth soccer field and a baseball field, but does not endorse a specific plan based on the information that has been provided to the Commission at this time.

**WHEREAS:** ANC 3E urges DPR to expedite the development of the youth soccer field.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** ANC 3E urges DPR, by July 15, 2004, to finalize plan for fields at Fort Reno, which may include reorientation of the baseball field from where it is shown on the drafts that were provided to the Commission on June 10. ANC 3E also urges DPR to submit this plan expeditiously to NPS for approval, and to seek clarification as to the specific restrictions that NPS will impose on the Fort Reno fields. At that point, DPR should present the final plan to the community within 30 days.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its regular meeting on June 10, 2004, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 3-0. Commissioners Chapman Todd, Lucy Eldridge, and Amy McVey were present.
