

**ANC3E Meeting
Minutes of December 12, 2002**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Commissioners Jill Diskan, Tad DiBiase, Chris McNamara and Frank Gordon were present. Commissioner Leslie Quynn was not present at the meeting.

Announcements:

Chairperson Diskan announced that the developers of 4600 Wisconsin Avenue, NW were planning to come before the ANC 3E board at the beginning of the New Year.

She also announced the renewal of two liquor licenses at Chadwicks, 5247 Wisconsin Avenue, NW and Club Cinema at Mazza Gallerie. The deadline to protest the renewal of the liquor licenses is December 30.

Commissioner McNamara announced that this was his final meeting as an ANC 3E commissioner and advised that it had been a pleasure to serve the neighborhood.

ANC Business/Actions:

Open Forum:

A representative from The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints located at 5460 Western Avenue explained that the church's congregation had declined with the introduction of restricted parking on Western Avenue and asked the commission to consider supporting the reinstatement of all day parking on Sundays in the area around the church. The commission agreed to put the issue on the January 2003 agenda.

Presentation by 2nd District Police:

Lt. Aiello introduced himself as the new lieutenant of the 2nd District Police and gave the crime update for the neighborhood. He emphasized the raise in thefts from automobiles in the neighborhood and reminded residents not to leave personal belongings in their vehicles.
