**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE TENLEY LIBRARY BUILDING
PROJECT (Draft)**

The Tenleytown, American University Park, Friendship Heights Advisory Neighborhood Commission voted 4 to 0, a quorum being present, to request that the Tenleytown library be planned in close consultation with the community. We also ask that the library be large enough to meet the current and projected needs of the fast growing community which will include approximately 1000 new housing units in the next few years. ANC3E urges the City to seriously consider a public/private partnership to develop the site on a scale appropriate to its location and proximity to the metro which is consistent with current and pending development along Wisconsin Avenue.

ANC 3E hereby supports the Tenleytown Neighbors Association's resolution dated February 14, 2003.

ANC3E approved this resolution by a vote of 4 to 0 at its monthly public meeting on April 10, 2003. The Commissioners present were Amy McVey, Amy Hoang, Lucy Eldridge and Matt Helfant.
