

2005-1 Resolution on DDOT plans to reconstruct/redesign Tenley Circle

Whereas: DDOT has notified ANC 3E that it intends to commence construction at Tenley Circle in the next week:

Whereas: DDOT is required to provide ANC 3E with at least 30 business days notice of any significant activity in order to provide for appropriate consideration and input from the affected community;

Whereas: DDOT has failed to provide ANC 3E with the required notice. Moreover, DDOT has failed to explain the reason for the construction, which will certainly cause considerable disruption to traffic going through the circle.

Be it resolved that ANC 3E requests that DDOT immediately halt its plans to commence construction and provide ANC 3E with the required notice of 30 business days and not commence plans until ANC 3E has had the opportunity to discuss and vote on the issue. We further request that DDOT send agency representatives to any special meeting that may be called by ANC 3E or ANC 3F so that the issue can be appropriately considered.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its regular meeting on February 10, 2005, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 4-0. Commissioners Chapman Todd, Lucy Eldridge, Amy McVey and Anne Sullivan were present.
