**Resolution to negotiate voluntary agreement with
Cost Plus, Inc. (d/b/a World Market) regarding application
for transfer of an alcoholic beverage Retailer's License B**

Whereas, Cost Plus, Inc. (d/b/a World Market) (hereinafter, Applicant) has filed an application for transfer of an alcoholic beverage Retailer's License B for the operation of a retail store selling furniture, home furnishings, gourmet foods, beer and wine located in the Chevy Chase Pavilion at 5335 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W.;

Whereas, ANC 3E and Applicant are attempting to finalize a voluntary agreement, which agreement, once executed, will resolve the various concerns of ANC 3E regarding Applicant's use of the liquor license, including, but not limited to, an increased parking burden on the immediate neighborhood;

Whereas, Applicant's roll call hearing before the ABC Board is scheduled for July 13, 2005. Any protest to the application, therefore, must be filed by June 28, 2005, fifteen days prior to the hearing.

Be it resolved that ANC 3E shall file a protest with the ABC Board to the transfer to Applicant of an alcoholic beverage Retailer's License B for the operation of a retail store located in the Chevy Chase Pavilion at 5335 Wisconsin Avenue, N.W.

Be it further resolved that ANC 3E shall grant SMD 3E04 Commissioner Lucy Eldridge authority to finalize the voluntary agreement between ANC 3E and Applicant that will enable ANC 3E to withdraw its protest prior to or at the time of the July 13, 2005 roll call hearing.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its regular meeting on June [TK] 2005, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 4-0. Commissioners Chapman Todd, Lucy Eldridge, Amy McVey and Anne Sullivan were present.
