**Resolution to support the District Department of Transportation's proposed project  
for Tenley Circle.**

**Whereas**, the District's Department of Transportation (DDOT) has prepared plans for the reconstruction of Tenley Circle, has met with ANC 3E and other community members to discuss these plans, and has made modifications based on these discussions;

**Whereas**, DDOT presented these modified plans at the regularly scheduled ANC meeting which was duly noticed and held on March 10, 2005, and answered questions of the Commission and interested neighbors;

**Be it resolved** that ANC 3E supports the Tenley Circle project, as modified and presented by DDOT staff at the ANC 3E meeting on March 10, 2005. ANC 3E's support of this project is only in regard to the section of the proposed work that is included within the boundaries of this Commission, and ANC 3E is specifically not taking a position on the area which is within the boundary of ANC 3F. ANC 3E's support of this proposed project is contingent upon DDOT's commitment, which was made at the March 10, 2005 meeting, to have an ongoing discussion with the following three groups on issues of particular interest to each of these groups:

1. Representatives from American University regarding the relocation and reconstruction of the stone wall on the west side of the Circle by the Tenley Campus of the University.
2. Representatives of St. Ann's Church regarding the width of the sidewalk and placement of tree boxes at the corner at Wisconsin and Yuma, just outside of the Church's main entrance.
3. Representatives of the Wisconsin Avenue Beautification Committee to have a pre-construction discussion with contractors regarding the importance of working around existing plantings at the Circle.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its regular meeting on March 10, 2005, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 4-0. Commissioners Lucy Eldridge, Chapman Todd, Amy Hoang Wrona and Anne Sullivan were present.
