Dear Mr. Tangherlini:

We are writing regarding the schedule for comments and responses to the draft Wisconsin Avenue Transportation Study and the Addendum to the Friendship Heights Traffic Study.

The current DDOT schedule for comments and responses on these two drafts is:

- 1) Resident comments due to DDOT by July 15
- 2) DDOT Study Team will post a response to comments by July 22
- 3) Residents reply and any additional comments to DDOT by August 1

ANC 3E believes that this entire time frame is too short, but we are particularly troubled by the final step which would give the community only 6 business days to respond to the study team's planned July 22 posting. We are aware of a number of substantive comments that have been or will be submitted to DDOT by the July 15 deadline, and we believe that three weeks from the date of the Study Team's response to these comments is a more reasonable deadline for residents' to reply and make additional comments. If the Study Team's response does occur on July 22, our proposed deadline for community reply would be August 12.
