RESOLUTION REGARDING PUBLIC SAFETY INFORMATION AND CRIME REDUCTION GOAL

WHEREAS, violent crime has declined nationally and in the District of Columbia in recent years, with violent crime District-wide declining for each of the last four out of the past five years, and

WHEREAS, DC's PSA 202 has not shared in this decline, and has instead seen no significant reduction in violent crime, with an average of 44 incidents over the past five years, and 43 incidents in the first year of this period, and

WHEREAS, PSA 202 saw a higher level of violent crime this past year than it has in the past five years, and

WHEREAS, violent crime in three of four adjacent PSAs, PSAs 201, 203, and 205 ("Adjacent PSAs"), is consistently a fraction of violent crime in PSA 202, and

WHEREAS, non-violent crime is likewise consistently lower in the Adjacent PSAs,¹ and

WHEREAS, unlike the Adjacent PSAs, PSA 202 contains two business districts, two Metro stations, two high schools (one public), a public middle school, and two public elementary schools, in addition to a far-flung residential district, all of which create the need for, and deserve, extensive policing; and

WHEREAS, although ANC 3E has been able to obtain only fragmentary information on deployment levels in PSA 202, the best information available suggests that, despite having considerably more crime and need for policing, PSA 202 is typically staffed at approximately the same level as the Adjacent PSAs, with perhaps one or two additional full time equivalent officers available in PSA 202 in a given month, and

WHEREAS, public safety is an issue that falls squarely within ANC 3E's (and all ANCs') jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, obtaining regular information on deployment, citations written, cases closed, and other indices of police activity would materially assist ANC 3E in providing advice regarding public safety, and

WHEREAS, it appears that such information is easily available via electronic databases, and

WHEREAS, Mayor Gray has promised to “[p]rovide the community with transparency regarding deployment,” and has taken the position more broadly that “[t]ransparency, accountability, and oversight of Department matters, including accurate reporting of staffing and resource allocation are necessary” to build trust with the community and achieve real community policing, and

WHEREAS, ANC 3E suspects that PSA 202 is inadequately staffed given the public safety challenges it faces, and

WHEREAS, ANC 3E nonetheless does not wish to micromanage the professionals who serve on and lead our police force, but instead wants and reasonably expects to see crime, especially violent crime, significantly reduced in our community, and

WHEREAS, senior MPD officials encourage middle managers to set goals, often ambitious goals, for reducing crime each year in areas under their purview, and

WHEREAS, senior MPD officials have identified a 5% annual reduction in crime as reasonable, and sometimes expect considerably greater annual reductions, and

WHEREAS, had violent crime in PSA been reduced by 5% annually, without compounding, for five years using as a baseline the five-year average of 44 incidents per year, the community could expect 33 incidents this year, with a slightly lower expected rate if the same reduction was applied to the rate at the beginning of this period, 43 incidents per year,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC 3E respectfully calls upon the Metropolitan Police Department to do the following:

1. Provide detailed written information to the ANC, on a regular, monthly basis, concerning
 - a. deployment, citations written, cases closed, and such other indices of police activity as MPD believes may be helpful to the ANC and the public, and
 - b. crimes such as simple assault that are not addressed, or fully addressed, via 2D listserv postings;
2. Commit to a goal of reducing violent crime incidents to 35 in 2011 and 30 in 2012, and to reducing non-violent crime, traffic violations, and other infractions significantly, and acknowledge that MPD’s performance in PSA 202 should be judged against that goal.

The resolution passed by a vote of 5-0 at a properly noticed meeting held on February 10, 2011, at which a quorum was present.
