Resolution regarding DDOT's proposal to install additional Capital Bikeshare stations in ANC 3E

Whereas, the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has announced [plans](#) to expand Capital Bikeshare (CABI) with a decision due by the end of 2015 on the location of additional stations, and

Whereas, currently there are only three CABI stations located within the boundaries of ANC 3E at [39th and Veazey Streets](#), [Wisconsin Avenue and Albemarle Street](#) and at [Wisconsin Avenue and Fessenden Street](#), and

Whereas, Montgomery County has in the last two years installed a number of CABI stations including 2 just across Western Avenue in Friendship Heights, MD, and

Whereas, American University (AU) has already committed to including a CABI station on the Tenley Campus and has advised ANC 3E that the station should be installed before the law school relocates to Tenleytown for the Spring 2016 semester, and

Whereas, Ward 3 is currently underserved by CABI with only 15 CABI stations in the Ward out of a total of 350 stations in the region, and

Whereas, DDOT has proposed an additional CABI station in ANC 3E adjacent to the Jenifer Street entrance to the Friendship Heights metro station on the west side of the 5200 block of Wisconsin Avenue and has also proposed a CABI station in ANC 3E at the intersection of 48th Street and Massachusetts Avenue NW with both stations to be installed in fiscal year 2016, and

Whereas, best practices suggest that in order for CABI to be effective there must be a concentration of stations and Ward 3 is currently lacking such a concentration of stations, and

Whereas, despite the lack of stations in Ward 3 ridership has steadily increased year over year, and

Whereas, ANC 3E has previously supported the installation of bike boulevards in ANC 3E on 41st and Jenifer Streets and is also considering proposals from DDOT to add short bike lanes on 39th and 44th Streets within ANC 3E, and

Whereas, Ward 3 in fact has high density corridors along Connecticut, Wisconsin and Massachusetts Avenue but these same corridors lack good east-west connectivity but are separated by short distances ideally suited for CABI trips and are served by excellent north-south public transit options, and

Whereas, on October 11, 2012 ANC 3E unanimously passed a resolution requesting DDOT install CABI stations at the two proposed locations in ANC 3E.

Now therefore be it resolved, ANC 3E supports DDOT's proposal to add an additional CABI station adjacent to the Jenifer Street entrance to the Friendship Heights Metro and also supports DDOT's proposal to add a CABI station at 48th Street and Massachusetts Avenue NW.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its meeting on November 12, 2015, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 5-0-0. Commissioners Jonathan Bender, Amy Hall, Jonathan McHugh, Tom Quinn and Anne Wallace were present.
