1. Tenleytown resident Stephen Voss (“Applicant”), intends to apply to the DC Commission on Arts & Humanities for a Public Art Grant designed to encourage public art in Tenleytown and promote knowledge of Tenleytown’s history.
2. If Applicant’s application is approved, the grant funds will be used to create a mural on the south side of the building located at 4425 Wisconsin Avenue NW.
3. Applicant has sought and obtained input from the community by means of an online survey. In addition, Applicant has met with the Tenleytown Historical Society and Tenleytown Main Street.
