To whom it may concern:

I write to convey ANC 3E's support for Make Music Day in Tenleytown on July 21, 2016. Tenleytown Main Street will join with Make Music DC to celebrate the longest day of the year with free, live music performances at venues up and down Wisconsin Avenue. The music festival is part of a global celebration of music-making in over 700 cities and 120 countries, inspired by France's renowned Fête de la Musique.

Make Music Day will offer veteran and amateur musicians the opportunity to perform in public parks and at local businesses, allowing community members of all ages to interact with and create music. The free, outdoor performances span all genres - from classical to punk, flamenco to funk, choral groups to soloists.

The day will begin with a performance by Crush Funk outside the Tenleytown-AU Metro from 8 – 9 AM. Then, from 1 – 8 PM, there will be live music at a dozen outdoor venues from Tenley Circle north to Fessenden St. at Washington College of Law, Tenley-Friendship Library, Janney Elementary School, Burger Tap & Shake, Whole Foods Market, Middle C Music, Bread & Salt, Steak-n-Egg, Classic Motors, City Bikes, Fessenden Park, and Coffee Nature.

A fun, community event, Make Music Day will strengthen the Wisconsin Avenue commercial corridor and engage the community.

ANC 3E authorized this letter by a vote of 4-0-0 at a properly noticed meeting held on June 9, 2016, at which a quorum was present, with Commissioners Bender, Quinn, Wallace, McHugh and Hall in attendance.
