**Re: Replacement of Traffic Control Signal – Ward 3  
Notice 17-29-TOA**

Dear Chairperson Bender:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D. C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

Currently, the intersection of 46th and Van Ness Streets, N.W. is controlled by a traffic signal. An engineering study indicates that the traffic control signal is no longer justified, and a decision has been made to replace the signal with all-way STOP control. All-way STOP control will be implemented in three steps: (1) Operate all-way RED flash on all four approaches of the intersection for a 30-day period; (2) Install all-way STOP signs on all approaches by deactivating/bagging the signal heads for a 60-day period; and (3) Upon the successful completion of the 90-day evaluation period, remove the traffic signal hardware and continue to operate under all-way STOP control.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing, no later than thirty (30) days after the date of this notice, with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Transportation Operations Administration at 55 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
