### **Resolution Regarding DC 311 Service request 13-00209640 regarding the 4100 and 4200 blocks of Livingston Street NW**

**Whereas**, the 4100 and 4200 blocks of Livingston Street NW (between 41<sup>st</sup> Street and Western Avenue NW) are unimproved and lack cement curbs which leave tree roots vulnerable to damage from parked cars and the lack of curbs also give the block a shabby and disorderly appearance, and

**Whereas**, the road way in these two blocks is badly in need of repaving, and

**Whereas**, the sidewalks on these two blocks in some stretches are in poor condition and in need of replacement, and

**Whereas**, Chevy Chase Park (aka Livingston Park) is located along these two blocks with its main entrance mid-block on the 4100 Block and the street is lacking a large pedestrian crosswalk at the main entrance or any other traffic calming or pedestrian safety devices, and

**Whereas**, DDOT recently removed 2 parking spaces mid-block and also has large no parking zones adjacent to the parks' main entrance on Livingston as well as at the intersection of 42<sup>nd</sup> and Livingston on a block with high parking demand due to its proximity to Chevy Chase Park, and

**Whereas**, the only resident of either block has indicated her support for adding curbs to the block and making other improvements.

**Therefore be it resolved** that ANC 3E urges DDOT to immediately plan for and add curbs and repave the roadway and repair the sidewalks on the 4100 and 4200 Blocks of Livingston Street NW, add some sort of pedestrian safety measure on the street adjacent to the main entrance to Chevy Chase Park on the 4100 Block of Livingston Street and we also urge DDOT to examine whether these two blocks need such large no parking zones and whether some parking restrictions can be reversed to create additional on street parking spaces.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its meeting on August 29, 2013, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 5-0-0. Commissioners Jonathan Bender, Matthew Frumin, Tom Quinn, Sam Serebin and Kathryn Tinker were present.
