### **Resolution Supporting the Application of the National Presbyterian Church, BZA Case No. 18426**

**Whereas**, on June 12, 2012, the National Presbyterian School (“NPS”) came before the requesting permission to renovate and expand its facilities, and made promises in writing and representations before the ANC and community.

**Whereas**, the incremental burden likely to occur if the application is granted is small, though not trivial.

**Whereas**, NPS has entered into a supplemental voluntary agreement under which it has agreed to provide certain benefits to the community in partial compensation and mitigation for the burden the increased enrollment would impose on the community.

**Therefore be it resolved**, ANC 3E supports the application of the National Presbyterian Church before the BZA in case number 18426.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at a publicly held meeting on October 11, 2012, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 5-0-0. Commissioners Jonathan Bender, Matthew Frumin, Tom Quinn, Beverly Sklover and Sam Serebin were present.
