A Joint Resolution Regarding Modernization of Proper ANC Notice by City Agencies

WHEREAS city agencies provide notice to ANCs of matters pending before those agencies where ANC input is given great weight; and

WHEREAS ANCs in Ward 3 do not consistently receive such notice and when received are often not in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS the notification process from city agencies to the ANCs can be modernized to include not only its current paper-based notification system but an electronic notification delivery system as well; With the term "electronic delivery" to include but not be limited to any form or variation of existing web based communications, email communications, digital communications, etc.;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the ANC 3E joins other Ward 3 ANC's in recommending the Mayor:

- a) Require the city agencies to not only provide paper notification to ANCs but add electronic notification as well, at least 45 days in advance of the agency's consideration of the matter, with specific focus on the notifications from the DC Department of Regulatory Affairs (DCRA), the DC Department of Transportation (DDOT), with specific emphasis on DDOT Public Space (PS) and DDOT's Paving Schedule, as well as issues related to proposed safety and traffic calming measures, the Historic Preservation Office (HPO), and the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA); and
- b) Provide an option to receiving commissioners so they may individually choose the best possible notice delivery system to them by requesting a) both paper and electronic notification, b) paper only notification (electronic opt-out), or c) electronic only notification (paper opt-out).
- c) Require that relevant notification and related information be searchable by Ward, ANC, and SMD in the information systems of the city by the ANC Commissioners; and
- d) Review progress of notice modernization at the quarterly Mayor's meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that action may be needed by the DC Council to approve and promote the modernization of the ANC notification process described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ANC 3E joins other Ward 3 ANC's in authorizing its Chair or duly appointed representative to appoint a common speaker to present this Resolution to its intended recipient.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its August 15, 2012 meeting, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 5-0-0. Commissioners Jonathan Bender, Matthew Frumin, Tom Quinn, Sam Serebin and Beverly Sklover were present.
