RESOLUTION REGARDING RENEWAL OF BTS TWO LLC ABRA LICENSE #097478

WHEREAS, BTS TWO LLC (operating as Burger Tap & Shake) and referred to herein as the Applicant, has applied to District of Columbia Alcohol Beverage Administration (ABRA) for renewal of its alcohol beverage license at its premises located at 4445 Wisconsin Avenue NW, ABRA-097478 and;

WHEREAS, since the Applicant opened for business nearly a year ago, its trash has been stored in two dumpsters located on public space on the sidewalk of Albemarle Street NW in violation of DDOT regulations; and

WHEREAS, the storage of trash in said dumpsters also creates litter in violation of ABRA regulations; and

WHEREAS, Applicant has failed to cure the violations despite notice and requests from the ANC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, the Commission protests the renewal application on grounds that Applicant has failed to maintain the premises in a neat and orderly manner; and be it further

RESOLVED, the Commission authorizes Commissioner Wallace to represent it in all proceedings related to this protest, and to advance any arguments and evidence they deem appropriate to demonstrate why the Application should not be renewed.

The Commission approved this resolution at its meeting on April 14, 2016, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 4-0-0. Commissioners Bender, McHugh, Quinn and Wallace were present.
