PSA 202 Crime Trends:

There were 6 violent crimes in PSA 202 in April, which is well above average for the year and twice as many as were committed in April 2015. Four of these violent crimes were robberies and in 3 of the robberies the victims were HS students. Arrests were made in 2 of the robberies and police have identified persons of interest in the other 2 robberies. Property Crimes were down in April. Over 88% of all Thefts (15 out of 17) occurred along the commercial corridors within the PSA; most were shoplifting offenses.

Sex Abuse (1 Total)

- Friday, April 1, 12:38 AM: 4500 Block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. Criminal Complaint Number (CCN) 16049707. There is no danger to the public at large.

Robbery Excluding Gun (4 Total)


- Thursday, April 19, 5:40 PM: 4000 block of Chesapeake St, NW. CCN 16061188. The suspects approached the victim with a knife. They took the victim's phone, wallet, and debit card pin number before fleeing on foot. Three juvenile suspects were arrested and charged.
- Thursday, April 19, 6:00 PM: 4200 block of Brandywine St, NW. CCN 16061177. The suspects approached the victim with a knife. The suspects took the phone and also stole a credit card before fleeing. Three juvenile suspects were arrested and charged.
- Monday, April 25, 4500 block of Grant Rd, NW. CCN 16064687. A Wilson High School student was approached by a suspect who demanded the victim's property as he exited his vehicle. After a struggle, the victim (juvenile) suffered a stab wound to his leg and the suspect fled. The victim was treated for non-life threatening injuries. A person of interest has been identified.

- Wednesday, April 27, 4200 block of Davenport St, NW. CCN 16066144. Three subjects approached a GDS student outside of the school and stole his cell phone. A person of interest has been identified.

Assault with Dangerous Weapon Gun (1 Total)
