PSA 202 Crime Trends:

Most of the thefts (21 out of 26) occurred along the commercial corridors in the PSA (Western Ave, Wisconsin Ave and 40th St/Ft Drive). Property Crimes in the PSA was significantly lower, 38% decrease, in August from July 2015. Since the beginning of the year, on average, there has been 2.5 Violent Crimes per month, and 48.5 Property Crimes per month, which makes August an average month for Violent Crimes and a below average month for all Property Crimes.

Crime Details by Category:

Details of crimes are listed when received from the MPD. Maps are provided for Thefts and Thefts from Autos to provide the reader with a visual depiction of where the crimes are occurring.

Sex Abuse (1 Total)

- Sunday, August 16, 1:30 AM: 5200 Block of Massachusetts Ave, NW. Complainant reported that an acquaintance that she knows only by first name sexually assaulted her.

Robbery Excluding Gun (1 Total)

- Wednesday, August 19, 5:25 AM: 4800 Block of Massachusetts Ave, NW. The suspect demanded the victim get out of her vehicle. The victim exited the vehicle and the suspect fled the scene. This is the same suspect, who took a vehicle near Sibley later that same day. The suspect was placed under arrest after a brief pursuit.


