PSA 202 Crime Trends:

For December, the only crimes reported in PSA 202 were Thefts and Thefts from Autos. Almost all of the Thefts (22 out of 24) took place along the commercial areas of PSA 202. All of the Thefts from Autos took place within 3 blocks of the commercial areas.

There were more Violent Crimes in PSA in 2016 than in 2015 (31 in 2016 vs. 28 in 2015, an 11% increase) but fewer Property Crimes (489 in 2016 vs. 623 in 2015, a 22% decrease). Within Violent Crimes, Robbery Excluding Gun dropped to 9 in 2016 from 20 in 2015 but Assaults with Dangerous Weapon Excluding Gun increased to 14 from 5 in the previous year. A large part of the decrease in Property Crimes came from a decrease in Thefts (286 in 2016 vs. 382 in 2015, a 25% decrease).
