PSA 202 Crime Trends:

There were 3 violent crimes in PSA 202 in January, which is a roughly average month. Property Crimes were roughly equivalent to January 2015 and lower than average. Over 76% of all Thefts (13 out of 17) occurred along and within two blocks of the commercial corridors in the PSA.

Crime Details by Category:

Assault with Dangerous Weapon Excluding Gun (3 Total)

- Monday, January 11, 4:29 PM: 5300 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. A suspect in a shoplifting ran out of a store. An employee of the store chased the suspect into the Friendship Heights Metro and produced a stun gun when confronted by the employee. An arrest was made.
- Tuesday, January 12, 6:09 PM: 4200 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. Two individuals got into a verbal argument and one struck the other with a cane several times. The case was closed with an arrest.
- Wednesday, January 20, 3:25 PM: 4500 block of 40th St, NW. A Wilson HS Student was stabbed and suffered non-life-threatening injuries across the street from the school.

Burglary (4 Total)

- Saturday, January 9, 10:07 PM: 4800 block of 48th St, NW. A man woke up and observed a subject standing in his hallway. The man screamed at the subject to get out of his house. The subject fled the home stealing some of the occupant's property
- Friday, January 15, 1:30 PM: 5200 block of 43rd St, NW. Unknown suspects entered the premises by forcing open a door in the rear of the house with unknown object. The complainant reported that nothing was taken.
- Tuesday, January 19, overnight: 4100 block of Harrison St, NW. Unknown suspects entered the residence through an unlocked front door and stole a purse/wallet and a laptop.
- Friday, January 22, 3:08 PM: 3900 block of Huntington St, NW. An unknown suspect entered a residence and stole a shopping bag containing assorted items. There were no signs of forced entry.
