PSA 202 Crime Trends:

There were 3 violent crimes in PSA 202 in May, which is about average for the year and slightly higher per month than in 2015. Arrests were made in the Robbery and one of the Assaults. Property Crimes were 50% higher in May than in April with a big increase in burglaries in the area. Most of the Thefts (18 out of 20) were from retail establishments.

Crime Details by Category:

Robbery Excluding Gun (1 Total)

- Tuesday, May 31, 3:00 PM: 4500 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. CCN 16087819. Three suspects approached the victim. One suspect snatched the victims phone. Two suspects were arrested (one is a juvenile). One suspect is still outstanding.


Assault with Dangerous Weapon Excluding Gun (2 Total)

- Saturday, May 7, 4:00 PM: 4100 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. CCN 16072330. The incident was domestic in nature and an arrest was made on the scene.
- Thursday, May 26, 7:34 PM: 5300 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. CCN 16084717. The suspect confronted 2 victims who were shopping. The suspect threatened both victims and spit on one of the victims and then fled. No arrests were made.


Stolen Auto (2 Total)
