PSA 202 Crime Trends:

There was 1 violent crime in PSA 202 in November, roughly the same as in October. Property Crimes were down 40% from October. October saw a spike in Property Crimes, so comparing November to September, there was a 12% drop in Property Crimes over September (45 vs. 51). About half of all Thefts (16 out of 31) occurred along the commercial corridors in the PSA. 11 out of 12 Thefts from Autos occurred along or within 2 blocks of the commercial corridors in the PSA. November crime was roughly lower than the year-to-date averages.

Assault with Dangerous Weapon Excluding Gun (1 Total)

- Friday, November 13, 3:28 PM: 4500 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. A man was stabbed outside the Tenleytown Metro. An arrest was made.
