Re: 4600 Wisconsin Avenue – Temporary closure of Brandywine Street, NW for  
DC Water Sanitary & Storm Tie-ins

Dear Neighbor,

The 4600 Wisconsin Avenue, NW construction project is mobilizing to coordinate connections to the DC Water sanitary and storm infrastructure. To that effort, the project team has procured the required permits to begin the site utility work within Brandywine Street, NW. Given the location and 15'-0" depth of the existing storm and sanitary mains, the connections will require the temporary road closure of Brandywine Street from Wisconsin Ave. to the Friendship Animal Hospital (before the alley – please refer to attached traffic control plan) in order to safely perform the work. As the sanitary and storm lines are located in the center of the street, it is not possible create a safe work zone and reroute traffic on either side of the work area. We have coordinated with DDOT who is requiring that the temporary road closure take place in the evenings only to minimize disruption (10:00pm – 4:30am) for a duration of approximately 2 weeks beginning on Monday 6/1/15. After which time, one lane of through traffic will be maintained at all times on Brandywine Street.

During the temporary road closure of Brandywine Street, a detour will be in place for traffic headed northbound on Wisconsin Ave. to River Road (please refer to the attached traffic control plan). The detour will direct traffic to make a left on Chesapeake Street (in lieu of Brandywine Street) and followed by a right on River Road. Again, this detour will only be in place when Brandywine Street is temporarily closed in the evenings (10:00pm – 4:30am) for approximately 2 weeks. Please note that pedestrian access will not be affected during the temporary road closure.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your cooperation as we work to complete this project.
