2. Project Information

Name of Project 19th Ed. *Resource Guide* Printing

Description of Project

One of Iona's earliest publications was Iona's *Resource Guide*, which we have published every two years for decades. In honor of our 40th anniversary, we have completely revised this publication of aging-related services, adding new service sections and many new service providers. This 19th edition has expanded to 276 pages and is the most comprehensive resource of its kind in the area.

Every year, approximately 15,000 print *Resource Guides* are distributed to individuals, community groups, libraries, businesses, hospitals, and social service providers in the greater metropolitan area. We routinely receive calls requesting this resource. It is available online as well as in hard copy and it is always free of charge.

Where will additional funds needed to complete the project come from?

The cost of printing 30,000 copies of the 19th edition of the *Resource Guide* is \$25,500. We have secured a grant of \$2,500 from the Rotary Foundation of Washington, DC and \$2,000 from Poor Roberts Charities. Additional private donations will also be applied to the cost of the printing.

Describe the benefits to the residents of ANC 3E

Iona serves a great number of people in Ward 3, including ANC 3E. Iona has been a trusted community resource in the neighborhood for four decades. The *Resource Guide* is available free of charge and is available for pickup at our location in Tenleytown. If a group (such as a tenants' association or faith community) is interested in ordering them in bulk to distribute to their

members, we can arrange delivery. The *Resource Guide* is useful for family caregivers, older adults themselves, professionals such as social workers and clergy.
