Re: 4600 Wisconsin Avenue – Site Utility Traffic Control – Night Permit Request


Dear Mr. Davis,

We have applied for a public space permit for the wet utility work serving our project under construction at 4600 Wisconsin Avenue, NW. We believe that it would be safer and in the best interest of the public for this work to be executed at night. If it is not allowable to conduct the work within Wisconsin Avenue at night, we would ask that DDOT consider issuing a night permit for the work on Brandywine Street as this would minimize the traffic disruption and impact to the adjacent businesses.
