RESOLUTION CONCERNING ZC CASE NO. 09-14

WHEREAS Safeway Inc. (“Safeway”) seeks a PUD in the above-referenced matter to expand its store at 42nd and Ellicott Streets, NW, and

WHEREAS ANC 3E has significant concerns about Safeway’s currently-proposed project, including concerns related to burdens on nearby neighbors, pedestrian safety, and lack of environmental and other amenities, and

WHEREAS Safeway has requested that the Zoning Commission (“ZC”) indefinitely postpone the ZC hearing set for January 14, 2010, to permit Safeway to “evaluate the many recommendations and concerns that it has received regarding the proposed development,” and

WHEREAS ANC 3E believes that granting Safeway’s request for postponement would serve the public interest,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, ANC 3E respectfully asks the Zoning Commission to grant Safeway’s request to postpone indefinitely the January 14, 2010 hearing in this matter, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the ZC deny the request to postpone this hearing, ANC 3E opposes Safeway’s PUD application, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ANC 3E authorizes Commissioner Jonathan Bender to represent it before the ZC regarding this matter.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its meeting on January 4, 2010, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 5-0.

Commissioners Jon Bender, Mathew Frumin, Lucy Eldridge, Sam Serebin, and Beverly Sklover were present.
