Resolution Regarding Application by Capital Wine School for modification to Retail Class C Tavern License to Serve Alcoholic Beverages, ABRA-086613

Whereas, The Capital Wine School LLC (“Capital Wine School”) has sought permission from the District of Columbia Alcoholic Beverage Administration (ABRA) to modify its existing license from a Retailers Class D Tavern License to a Retailers Class C Tavern License to enable them to serve spirits in addition to wine in a room located at 5207 Wisconsin Avenue NW, Suite 7, and

Whereas, ANC 3E previously entered into a voluntary agreement with the Capital Wine School at its April 12th, 2011 meeting and passed a resolution in support of the original application for a liquor license at that same meeting, and

Whereas, the voluntary agreement permits use of the aforementioned facility by applicant and any successor licensee solely for the purposes of operating a wine school, and

Whereas, in this voluntary agreement the applicant has also committed to discourage driving and to seek out parking for its customers, and

Whereas, since supporting the original liquor license ANC 3E has not been made aware of any complaints about the operation of this business and does not believe modifying the license to allow the sale of spirits will likely create any additional burden on the community.

Now therefore be it resolved, ANC 3E supports Capital Wine School’s application to modify its Retail Class D Tavern License to a Retailers Class C Tavern License, provided that the applicant is still bound by the terms of the existing voluntary agreement, will continue to adhere to such terms as they apply to a wine school and will enter into a revised agreement that makes technical changes to the existing agreement so that it explicitly applies to, authorizes and governs the sale of spirits, and

Be it further resolved, ANC 3E respectfully asks ABRA to embody the conditions specified in such a voluntary agreement in any order granting the modified license sought by Capital Wine School.

ANC 3E approved this resolution at its meeting on October 9, 2014, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present. The resolution was approved by a vote of 4-0-0. Commissioners Jonathan Bender, Matthew Frumin, Tom Quinn and Sam Serebin were present.
