
Dear Commissioner Hood and Members of the Commission:

On November 5, 2015 the Applicant initially filed materials in the above-referenced matter. After consultation with the District’s Office of Planning, neighbors, and community groups, the Applicant has elected to pursue a different development strategy for the Property than that set forth in the Application. The Applicant no longer desires to seek a PUD or Zoning Map amendment and will pursue its new proposal for a portion of the Property before the Board of Zoning Adjustment.

Pursuant to Subtitle Z, Section 706 of the Zoning Regulations, the Application will be deemed dismissed without prejudice in November 2017 because no public hearing was held within two years of the date of application. However, the Applicant wishes to expedite the dismissal of the Application. Accordingly, the Applicant hereby withdraws its Application and requests that the Commission dismiss without prejudice the above-referenced PUD Application.


