**Re: 44<sup>th</sup> St NW & Jenifer St NW Protected Bike Lanes**

Dear Chairperson Bender and Commissioners,

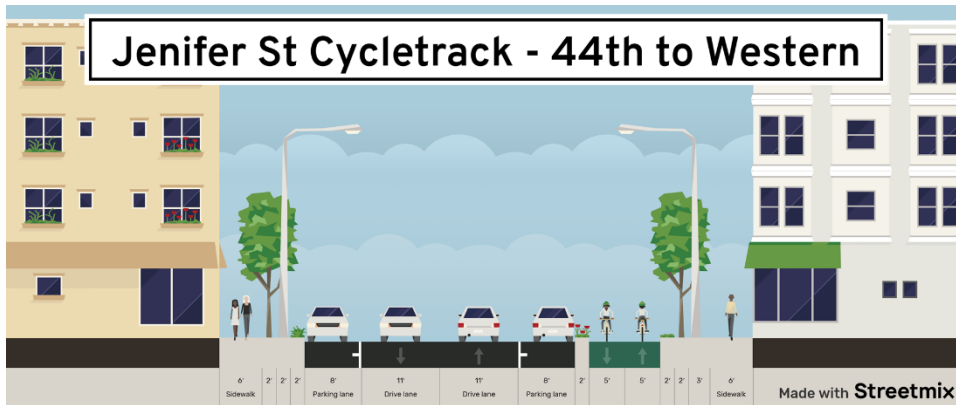
Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written Notice of Intent (NOI) on proposed traffic and parking modifications.

DDOT proposes to reconfigure 44<sup>th</sup> Street NW and Jenifer Street NW as shown in the plans, and install a Protected Bike Lane (PBL) on both corridors. Approximately 230’ (11 spaces) of parking will be removed from the north and south sides of Jenifer as part of the conversion to protected bike lanes, and approximately 340’ (16 spaces) of parking will be removed from the east and west side of 44<sup>th</sup> Street. Parking setbacks from driveways are intended to improve sightlines between users, and are consistent with DDOT’s Design and Engineering Manual. Part of the change to parking is to ensure bus turns to the Western bus garage are maintained without interference from parked vehicles.

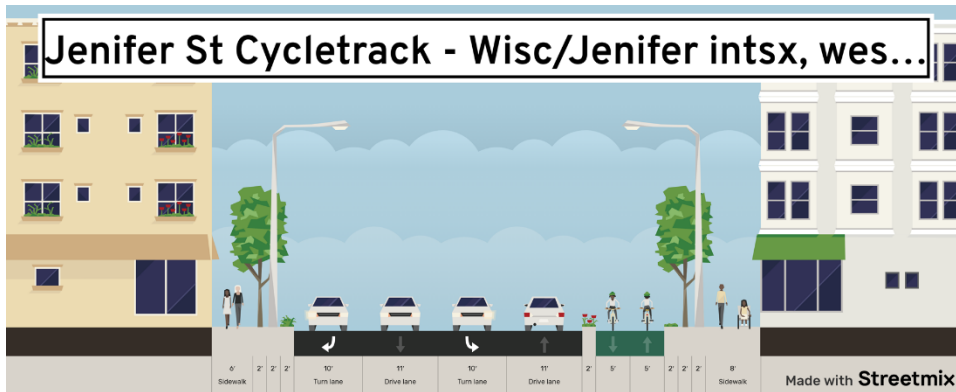
In general, the bicycle facilities will offer a protected environment between existing traffic diverters at 44<sup>th</sup>/Harrison Streets, and 43<sup>rd</sup>/Jenifer Streets, and will connect to an existing off-street bicycle facility on Western Ave, with future extension of facilities planned along Western Ave.

We are issuing this NOI at the 30% design stage to solicit public feedback through the ongoing development stages of this project.

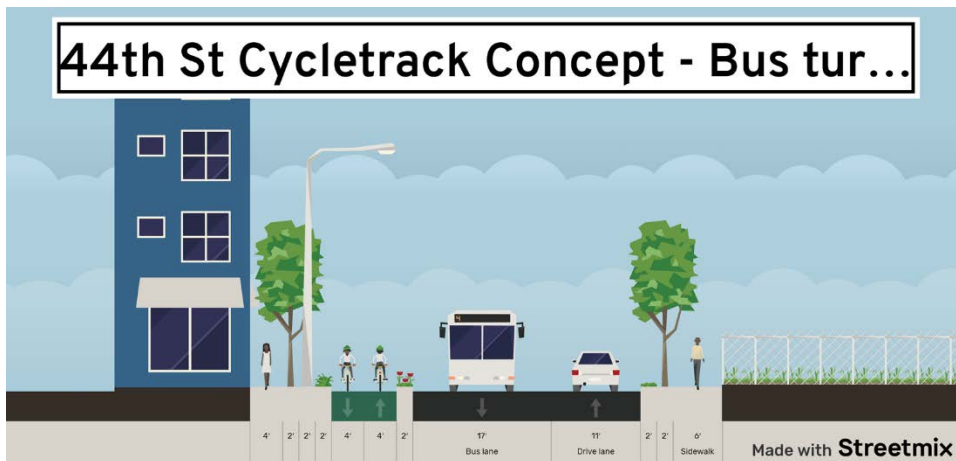
Proposed cross sections for the project are shown below:



*The cycletrack will be on the north side of Jenifer St*

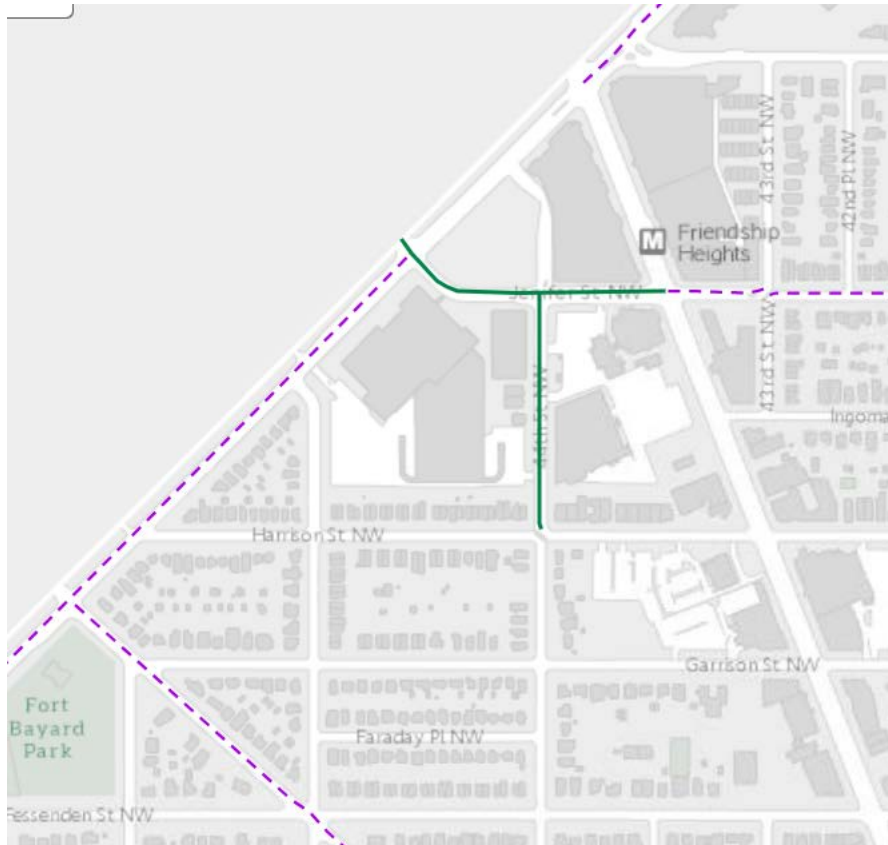


*The cycletrack on the north side allows for the fewest conflicts with vehicles at the Wisconsin Ave intersection*
