Crimes reported in February 2024 were 90% higher than in January 2024, 16% lower than in February 2023 and 47% lower than the average monthly number of total crimes since January 2015.

#### Crime Details by Category:

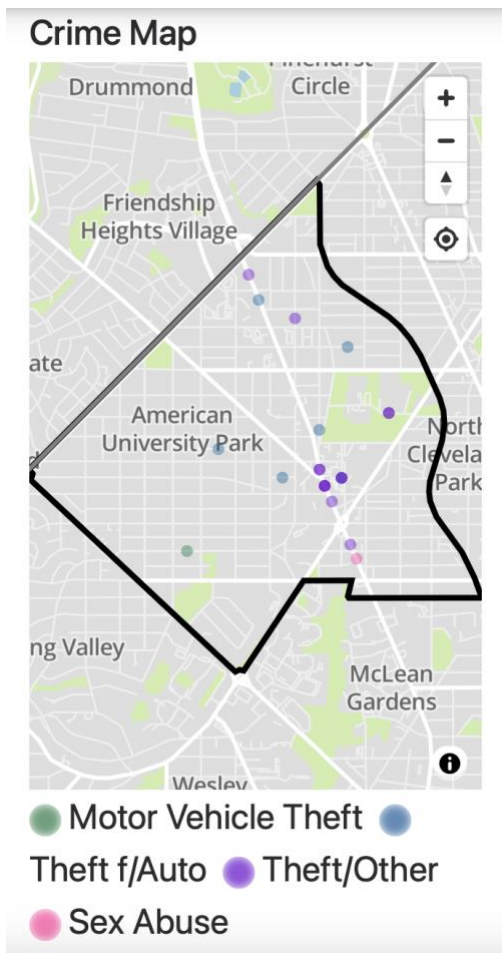
##### Sex Abuse (1 Total):

- Monday, February 26 at 12:05 AM; 4227 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW; CCN 24029517. The victim reported that the suspect engaged in an unwanted forced sexual act with her. The suspect is known to the victim and the case is being investigated by our Sex branch detective.

##### Motor Vehicle Theft (1 Total):

- Between Friday, February 9 at 9:00 PM and Saturday, February 10 at 10:00 AM; 4500 block of Warren St, NW; CCN 24021377. The reporting party stated that the vehicle was parked in front of their house, and it was missing the next morning. They have a camera, but it did not capture the vehicle being stolen and there were no other cameras in the immediate area. There was no glass on the

street or sidewalk. The one key to the vehicle was with the owner and the vehicle did not have any type of GPS device. This case is still open and the vehicle has yet to be recovered.
