PSA 202 Crime Trends:

Crimes reported in July 2023 were 24% higher than in June 2023 and 20% higher than in July 2022. The monthly average crime for 2023 is 21% higher than 2022 monthly averages (33.00 vs 27.25) and 19% lower than then historical monthly average from January 2015 through May 2023 (33.00 vs 40.59).

Crime Details by Category:

Robbery (1 Total)

- Monday, July 17 at 4:00 PM; 4800 block of Massachusetts Ave, NW; CCN 23115882. The complainant was at the CVS when she realized her wallet was missing from her purse. It was later discovered through surveillance footage that the suspect went inside her purse and stole her wallet.

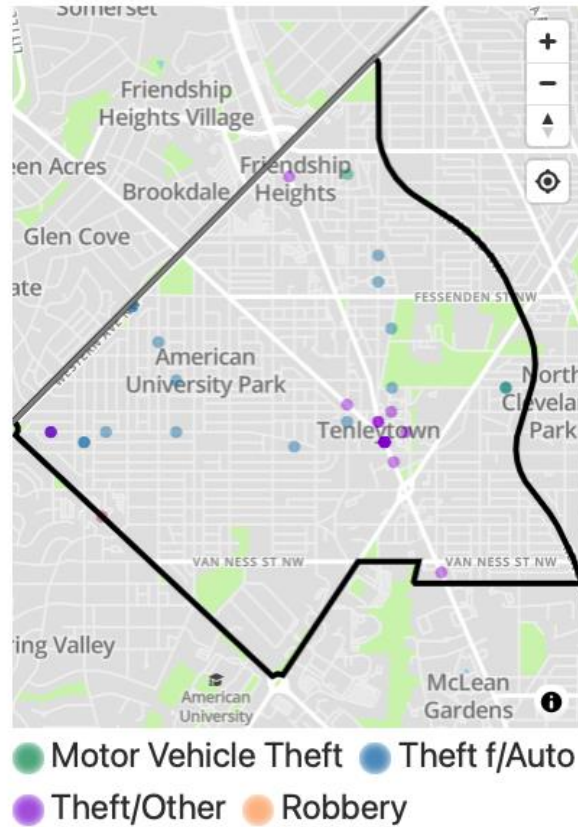
Motor Vehicle Theft (3 Total)

- Friday, July 7 at 11:33 PM; 3700 block of Chesapeake St, NW; CCN 23109961. The complainant stated that an unknown person broke the vehicle window and stole it while it was parked in front of their home when it was stolen. The vehicle was last seen heading west bound on Chesapeake Street. The vehicle

registration was inside the vehicle and car keys are in her possession. The vehicle was found the next day on the 3700 block of 30th ST NW at the intersection of Cleveland AVE and 30th ST NW.
