Violent and Property Crimes increased this month over last month and over October 2020. Total Crimes were 67% higher than the monthly average for this year, 13% higher than the 2020 monthly average and 7% higher than the monthly average from January 2015 until today.

Crime Details by Category:

Robbery (2 Total)

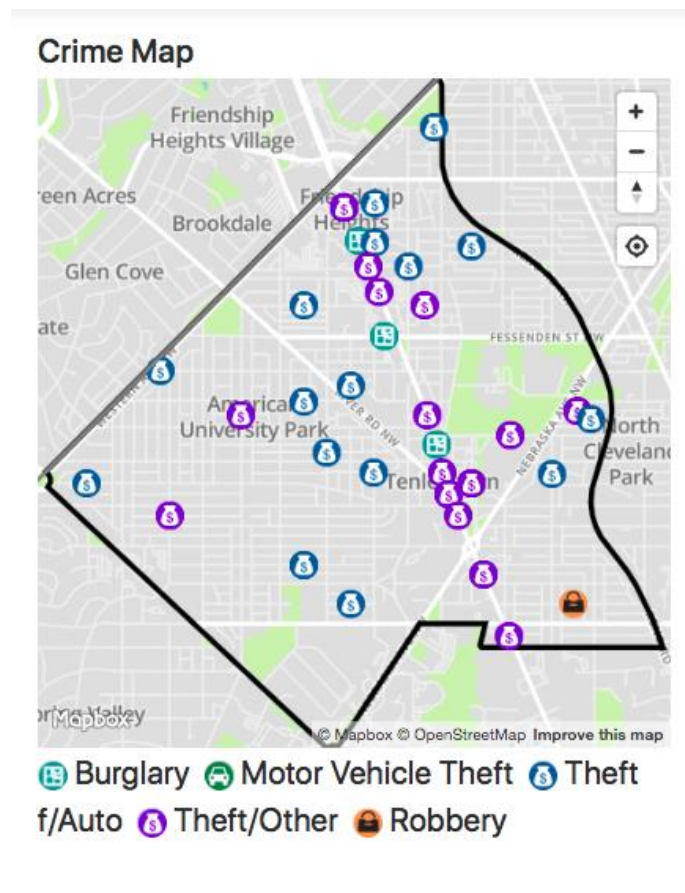
- Friday, October 8, 9:47 AM; 3700 block of Veazey St NW; CCN 21146211. The suspect approached the victim, pointed a handgun at them, and demanded their wallet. The victim stated that all he had was his keys and the suspect left without obtaining anything. This case is still open.
- Thursday, October 14, 6:00 PM; 5200 block of Wisconsin Ave NW; CCN 21149572. The suspect entered Paul's Wine and Spirits and produced a handgun. The suspect took money from the register, bottles of liquor and fled into the Metro. The suspect was apprehended as he was exiting the train at the Dupont Circle station. He was wanted also charged with 2 other robberies of liquor stores 2 nights prior.

Burglary (5 Total)

- Friday, October 1, 6:01 AM; 5224 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW; CCN 21141510. The suspect smashed the front door of the Verizon store with a rock and entered. Once inside an I-Phone 11 was stolen. This case is still open.

- Two males, one with a crowbar, entered the businesses and stole money from the cash register. They have committed over 15 burglaries throughout DC. There is a person of interest in these cases, but no arrests have been made thus far.

Motor Vehicle Theft (1 Total)
