PSA 202 Crime Trends:

Both Violent and Property Crimes in September were higher than our monthly averages. Thefts from Autos and Motor Vehicle Thefts continue to be significantly higher than average while Burglaries and Other Thefts are averaging lower than they were last year.

Crime Details by Category:

Assault with Dangerous Weapon (1 Total)

- Friday, September 28, 8:37 PM: 4500 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. CCN 18164383. An argument ensued between different parties and someone produced a knife and attempted to stab one of the victims.

Robbery (4 Total)

- Sunday, September 9, 3:30 PM: 4700 block of Nebraska Ave, NW. CCN 18151759. A group of friends were walking together when they were approached by several suspects who stole a wallet and cellphone from one of the victims.
- Friday, September 14, 4:20 PM: 5100 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. CCN 18155068. The victim reported that the suspect snatched the victim's property and fled on foot.
- Saturday, September 15, 2:45 PM: 4600 block of 40th St, NW. CCN 18155709. The complainant and his friends were approached by approximately 4 to 7 suspects. The complainant was separated from his friends and brought to the nearby alley where they went through his pockets and took his phone and wallet. No injuries reported. A juvenile suspect was stopped identified and placed under arrest.
- Friday, September 28, 2:45 PM: 4700 block of Wisconsin Ave, NW. CCN 18164147. A lone suspect approached a female pedestrian in the block and attempted to remove her purse. Two by standers

rendered assistance and the suspect fled to and jumped into a Black Cadillac Escalade and was last seen towards River Road.
