Crime Details by Category:

Assault with Dangerous Weapon (1 Total)

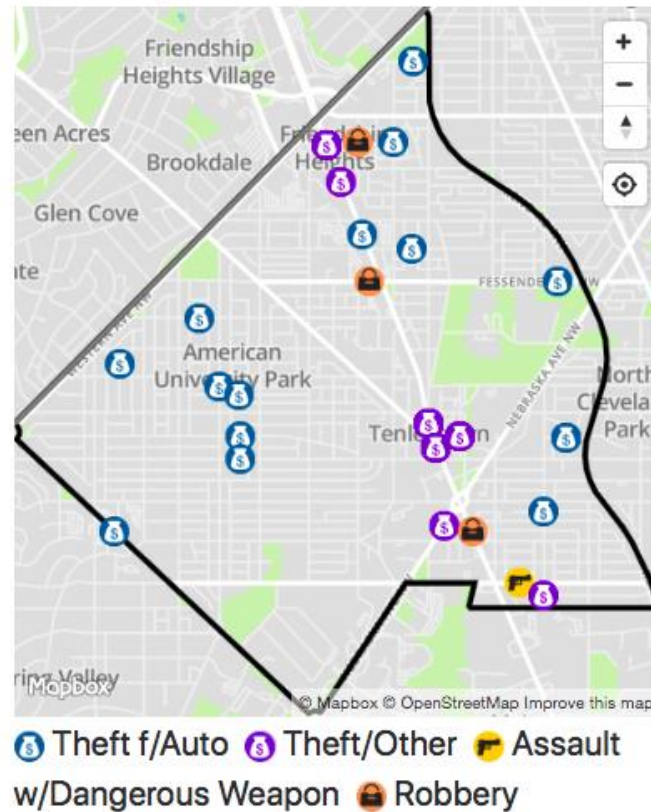
- Friday, September 3, 6:40 PM; 3800 block of Van Ness St NW; CCN 21125712. This was an incident between two juvenile females that are known to each other. One of the young ladies pulled a knife on the other. The case is still open.

Robbery (3 Total)

- Thursday, September 16, 10:42 AM; 5300 block of 43rd St NW; CCN 21132985. the suspect approached the victim at the listed location, brandished a handgun and demanded the victim's vehicle keys. The victim complied and the suspect fled the scene in the victim's vehicle. This case was closed with an arrest.
- Thursday, September 23, 10:15 PM; 4300 block of Wisconsin Ave NW; CCN 21137210. The suspect entered the 7-11, brandished a handgun and demanded US currency. The victim complied and the suspect fled the scene. The case was closed with an arrest.

- Friday, September 24, 2:30 AM; 4216 block of Fessenden St NW; CCN 21137270. The complainant was walking home and was approached by two suspects who demanded the victim give the suspects his money. The complainant ran away toward his house. One of the suspects found him and pepper sprayed him twice and entered the complainant's house. Another resident of the house overheard the commotion and found the complainant suffering from the effects of the pepper spray. The suspect was last seen running westbound on the 4200 block of Fessenden St NW.
