Installation of a Two-Way stop control (TWSC)**

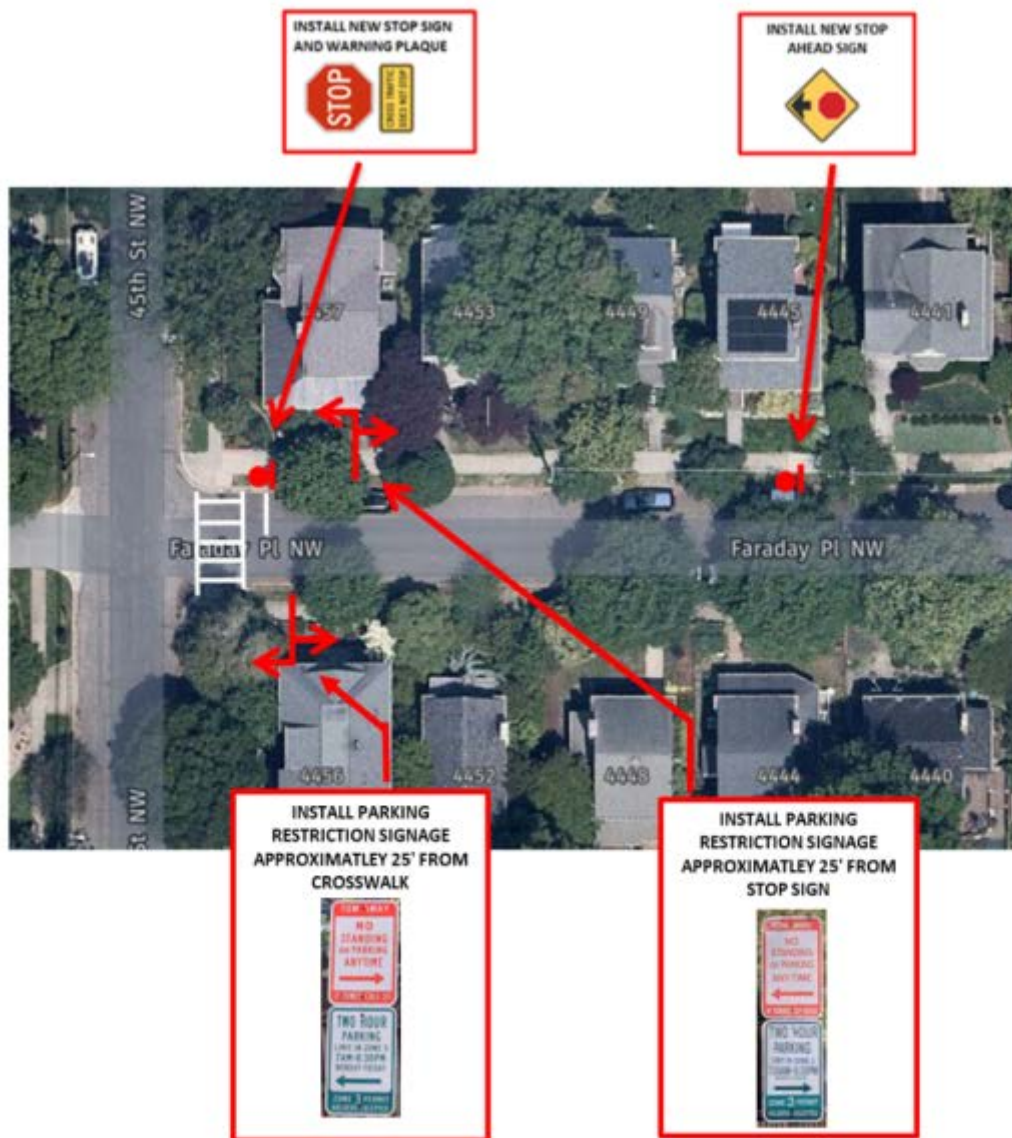
Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent (NOI) to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- **Installation of TWSC at the intersection of Faraday Place NW and 45<sup>th</sup> Street NW**

Currently, the "T" intersection of intersection of 45<sup>th</sup> Street, NW and Faraday Place, NW, operates as an uncontrolled intersection, where none of the intersection approaches are controlled by a stop sign or traffic signal. DDOT has reviewed the intersection and made a determination, through engineering judgement, to install a stop control at the Faraday Place approach of the intersection, to assist with safer navigation at this 'T' intersection for all roadway users. The approaches along 45<sup>th</sup> will operate as "free" or uncontrolled under this configuration.

Parking restrictions will also be installed or repositioned based on the regulations and standards as stated in the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR) and the DDOT Design and Engineering Manual (DEM).

**Figure 1** illustrates the proposed signs and pavement markings to be installed and/or refurbished as part of the intersection improvements.
