TNA and THS Grant Application

Description of Project

TNA and THS are 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations located within ANC3E. On Saturday, May 16, 2020, TNA will sponsor a street level walking tour of Armesleigh Park with a handout, food and refreshments, and entertainment. The handout will contain an abbreviated history of Armesleigh Park and several pages with pictures and descriptions of each of the fourteen house styles.

TNA and THS will sponsor a printed booklet of about 68 pages that will be provided to all 92 Armesleigh Park households, the Tenley-Friendship Library, the Martin Luther King Library, and other historical and civic organizations. The bound booklet will contain an extensive history of Armesleigh Park with color pictures and maps. A pdf of the booklet will be available via the THS website (www.tenleytownhistoricalsociety.org).

Benefits to the Residents of ANC3E

The May 16, 2020, celebration will be a free educational event in Armesleigh Park, Tenleytown, DC, which is within ANC3E. The 92 Armesleigh Park households will receive a 68-page bound booklet described above along with local libraries and historical and civic associations.
