Description of Project The Wilson High School Marching band will be participating in the Emancipation Day Parade on Monday, April 17, 2017. Wilson's band has a strong history, but in recent years the band has fallen short in numbers and equipment, and for several years was unable to march in the parade. Under the leadership of Paul Phifer, the band is being rejuvenated. The band marched for the first time in parade last year, and has more students to do so again this year. More students means the band needs more uniforms, and we are seeking a grant to pay for uniforms and necessary equipment and repairs.
