Dear Resident of the 4300 block of Harrison Street:

At Pepco, we are committed to providing safe, reliable, affordable and sustainable energy to our customers and communities in the District of Columbia.

As part of this commitment and in connection with the ongoing work at the Harrison Substation, transformers will be delivered to the site over the next two weeks, Tuesday, November 13<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, November 15<sup>th</sup> as well as Monday, November 19<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 12 midnight and 4 a.m. The deliveries will take place in the alley behind the houses in the 4300 block of Harrison Street. The reason the deliveries will occur during this timeframe is because the transformers are quite large, requiring special permits for transporting them through the streets of Maryland and the District. In fact, a Maryland State police escort will be provided up to the District line.

The transformers will be unloaded from a large tractor trailer on 44<sup>th</sup> Street near the WMATA bus garage onto a smaller flatbed that can maneuvered through the alley. If you park your car in the alley or keep garbage cans in the alley, we ask that you move them in order that the flatbed truck may have a clear path through. No customer outages will be necessary to complete this work; however, there will be some noise associated with this delivery.

As crews work, we ask that you remain clear of the worksite so that crews may work safely and efficiently. We are committed to working safely and will make every effort to minimize inconveniences to you and your neighbors.
